



A team comprised of scientists and practitioners has created a proprietary, participative assessment methodology named CoopeRATEr®. It is adapted continuously to changing requirements. The assessment methodology allows detecting problems in short time frames. Furthermore, clear indicators and benchmarks facilitate a systematic positioning.



The same methodology serves to clearly document progress and achievements, making it an indispensable and motivating management tool. However the methodology itself is not the goal, rather the assessment process is tailored to assist reflection and learning on all hierarchical levels.



A Governance Model as the Basis of our Consulting

Efficient organizations are characterized by a clear positioning and professional realization of their plans. Deficiencies in these areas may cause resources, ideas for innovation and action potentials to be lost. Scientific research calls this problem a governance-gap. Often organizations are not aware of its existence.

The practice of Aid Governance and a research project of several years at the University of St. Gallen with Prof. Dr. Patrick Renz show: governance-gaps hinder the optimal impact of many development organizations.

The decisive factors can be captured in a governance model with six modules. It views the organization as a whole, as well as viewing its context and management tasks.



This model helps to obtain an integrative and systematic understanding of a complex organization and to suggest sustainable and effective improvements of the current situation in a short time.
